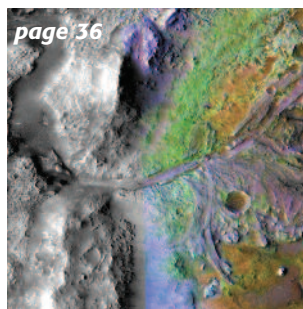
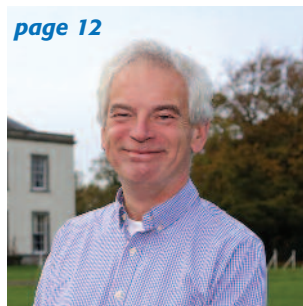
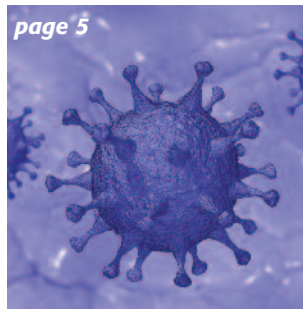

- 22** Triple planet alignment as Mercury passes Saturn then Jupiter. Mars skims past Uranus and is best evening planet all month. Mercury visible in evening skies. Quadrantid meteor shower may be good. ISS in evening skies. Venus near Moon one last time. Moon skims edge of Hyades cluster.
