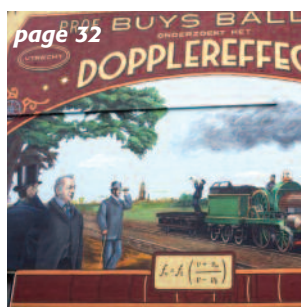
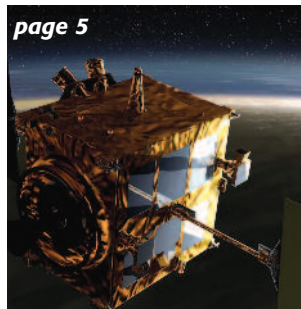

- 22 Mars is closest to Earth this month and blazes in evening skies with huge disk in telescopes - very close to Moon Oct.3rd too. Jupiter is very close to Moon Oct.22nd with Saturn nearby. Venus very close to Regulus (0.2°). Uranus at opposition. Draconid and Orionid Meteors Peak. ISS in evening skies again. And the Moon passes close to the Beehive cluster.
